## CIBO's 2009 Energy Policy Concerns 111 Congress

Promote industrial energy efficiency and the need for pollution-prevention exclusion under NSR

Promote Combined Heat and Power (CHP) and the need for realistic access to the grid and backup power support without stranded cost recovery by utilities for demand reductions or new energy generated and used on site.

Support Renewable Portfolio Standards (RPS) that are competitively priced fuels without increasing energy costs to the consumer while protecting the sources of wood as feed stock to many industries.

Support an Energy Efficiency Resource Standard such that allowances or credits can be traded 1 for 1 with RPS requirements.

Promote fuel flexibility and the use of alternative fuels and maximum extent possible.

Support energy efficiency technology, clean fuels and alternative energy research, development and demonstration with a 10% to 30% industrial project set aside managed through the National Energy Technology Laboratories Programs.

We continue to promote the distinction between the Industrial Community and the Utility Community and the need for separate consideration on issues associated with fuels, energy and energy efficiency.
