LEAN DEMOCRATIC 3 Dem • 4 Rep

2 Dem • 0 Rep

DEMOCRATIC TOSS UP REPUBLICAN TOSS UP 0 Dem • 23 Rep

LEAN REPUBLICAN 0 Dem • 27 Rep

LIKELY REPUBLICAN 1 Dem • 28 Rep

- Dems need 23 seats
- 6 Republican seats "Likely/Lean Dem"
- 50 Republican seats "Tossup/Lean R"
- Big Primary Day in CA
- Trending R



Looking to the 2018 Elections - Senate

Could Democrats win the Senate? Yes. Is the race for control a Toss-up? No. Republicans remain substantial favorites to retain the Senate majority.

- Dems need 2 seats
- 10 Trump State Dems Up / 1 Clinton State Rep
